Trade Offs to Consider

- Requires subscriptions for full content access
- Limited app selection compared to smart TVs
- No HDMI port for direct TV connections
- Dependent on cloud gaming subscriptions
- Battery-powered remote needs charging
- Free content options are limited
- No physical media playback support
