

## Trade Offs to Consider

---

- Battery life vs. wired power reliability
- Subscription costs for full feature set
- Limited color night vision in low light
- Dependence on internet connectivity

## How It Compares

---

- Better than basic cameras with two-way talk
- Less durable than wired security systems
- More expensive than non-IP cameras
- Requires subscription for advanced alerts
