Who It Is For

Who It Is Not For

-  Users without HDMI ports on their TV
-  Those needing wired Ethernet connectivity
-  People preferring physical remote buttons
-  Users without compatible streaming apps
-  Individuals without a router
-  Smart TV owners with built-in streaming

Trade Offs to Consider

-  No built-in smart TV features
-  Limited app selection compared to competitors
-  Requires HDMI port availability
-  No physical remote buttons
-  Dependent on router signal strength
-  Battery-powered remote needs replacements

How It Compares

- No smart TV integration capabilities
- Fewer streaming apps than Roku Ultra
- Requires HDMI port instead of USB-C
- Battery-powered remote vs. wired alternatives
- Longer Wi-Fi range than standard sticks
- Sleeker design than box-shaped players
